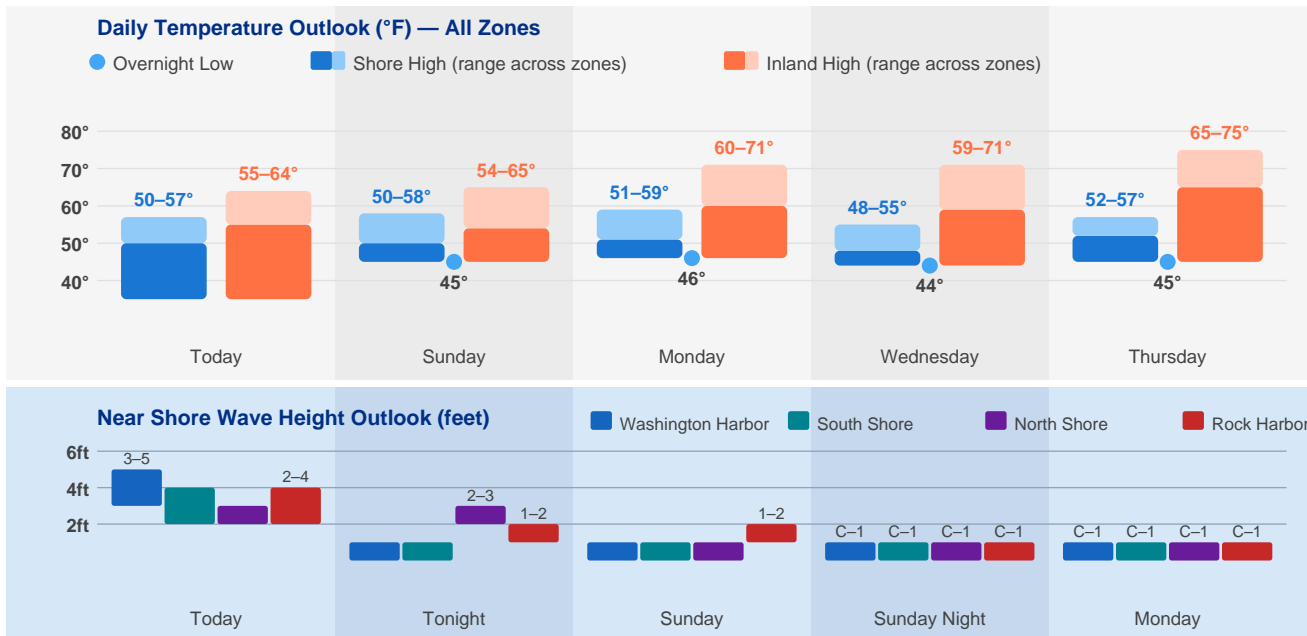

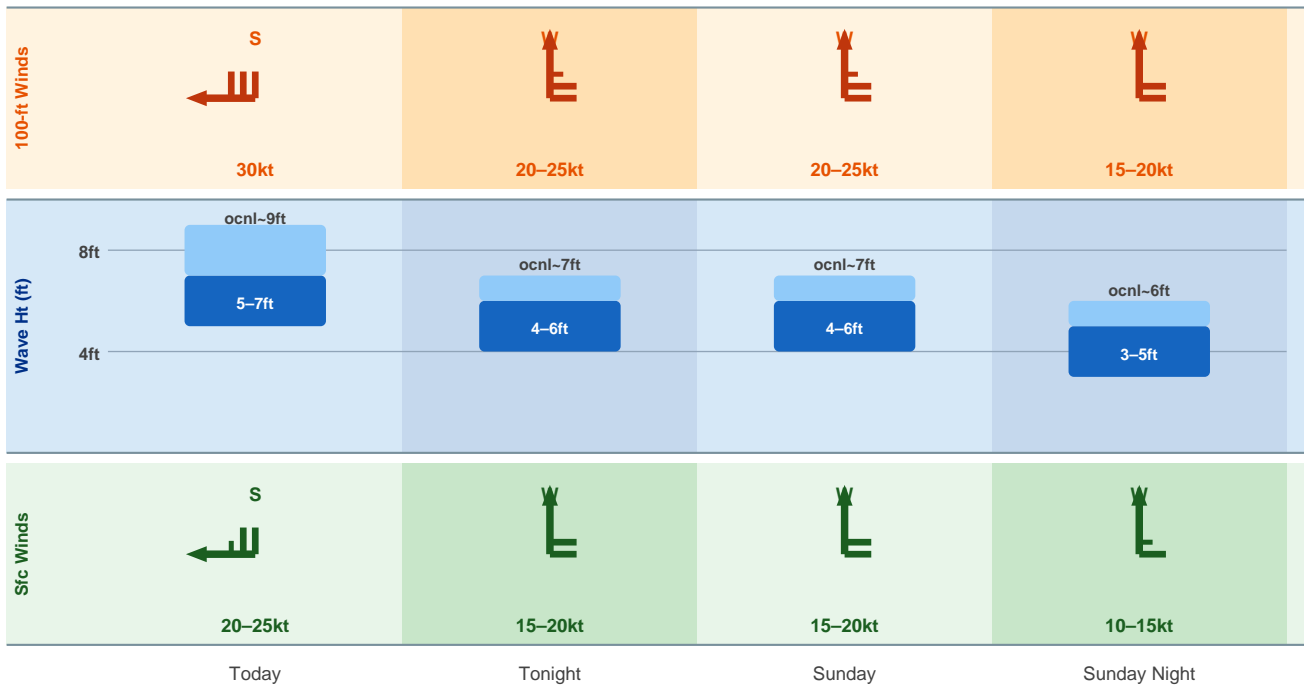

### Synopsis

A 29.6 inch trough will move through Lake Superior through this afternoon, followed by a 29.7 inch trough Sunday afternoon and evening. Weak ridging of 29.7 inches follows into Monday, but another 29.7 inch trough moves through the lake late Monday into Tuesday. Troughing of around 29.6 inches returns by late Tuesday before a low of 29.4 inches moves through the Great Lakes region Wednesday night and Thursday.
